## What Results Should I Expect?

Data from over 431,000 FTAI programs, showed an average pregnancy rate of 50.39% to a single Al

While a lot of industry data from numerous sources, places the average result around the 50% mark, this value is exactly that, an average. Many variables can dictate the outcomes of a program, so what is a good result for one herd may be a poor result for another.

The key is not to measure your success against your neighbour, or the average, but against your own farm business parameters.

Some of the variables that impact program results include:

**Breed** 

Age

Lactation status

Nutrition

Body condition score

Time since calving

Herd health - disease and parasite management

Weather events

Stress

Drug storage and handling

**Drug application** 

Type of protocol used

How well the protocol is followed

Semen quality

Semen handling (even during transport and thawing)

Experience of the AI technician

Management practices

Time since management changes have been implemented (before and after the AI)
